Any Ethiopian Undergraduate Regular Student of the Addis Ababa University, 2nd Year or Higher, at One of the units listed below, and having a Cumulative GPA of 3.00 and above is Invited to Apply for the 22nd (2018-2019) Aklilu Lemma Merit Scholarship Awards. For Beneficiary Departments within the CNS, Selection Preference Shall be made in the Order in which Departments are presented in the Table below.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 or Higher; Weighted 75% of Total.
Strong Confidential Letter of Recommendation by Relevant Department or College testifying to the Applicant's Serious Commitment to his/her Studies, Good Conduct and Other Achievements Including Active Participation in Extra & Co-Curricular Activities and Community Services; Weighted 20% of Total.
Short 'Personal Statement' Essay, Not Exceeding One Type written Page, to allow the Applicant to Emphasize Any Particular/Outstanding Aspect of His/Her Application; Weighted 5% of Total.

Successful Applicants Will Be Awarded a Certificate of Merit, a Monthly Stipend of Eth. Birr 300.00 during the 2018/2019 Academic Year, and some Other small Educational Material Support.
The Scholarship Award is Tenable for One Year and is Renewable until Graduation, provided the Awardee Maintains the cGPA Required for Renewal to be specified by college/school/institute committees at the time of selection.

II. APPLICANTS FOR RENEWAL OF ALF SCHOLARSHIP

- ALF Scholarship Recipients of 2017/2018 Who are not Graduating at the end of the Academic Year are Required to Submit the following before 01 July 2018: (i) Written Report about Benefits obtained During 2017/2018; (ii) A Formal Written Request applying for Scholarship Renewal for the year 2018/2019; (iii) An Up-to-date Confidential Recommendation Letter from the Department/School on the Special ALF Recommendation Letter Form provided; and (iv) a Copy of the Final Grade Report of 2017/2018. (Semester I Grade Report is a Must for complete application!!).

Please Pick Up (i) the Application Form and (ii) the ALF recommendation letter form from your College/School Or from the Central ALF Office, Located in the College of Natural Sciences; Freshman/Marshal Building (Room 106) and Submit complete Application up to 05 July 2018: No Application will be Accepted after this date! Incomplete Applications will Not be considered.

Please Submit Complete Application in Person to the ALF Office Before the Deadline (05 July 2018), and Submit Your Transcript or Final Grade Report of Semester II (2017/18) to the ALF Office as soon as it is available.
