I. NEW (FIRST TIME) APPLICANTS TO ALF

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

ALT: Truly Committed to Reward Excellence

Any Ethiopian Undergraduate Regular Student of the Addis Ababa University, 2nd Year or Higher, at One of the units listed below, and having a **Cumulative GPA of 3.00 and above** is Invited to Apply for the 18th (2014-2015) Aklilu Lemma Scholarship Awards. For Beneficiary Departments within the CNS, Selection Preference Shall be in the Order in which Departments are presented in the Table.

1. College of Natural Sciences (CNS)	2. School of Medicine

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

- Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 or Higher; Weighted 75% of Total.
- Strong Confidential Letter of Recommendation by Relevant Department or Faculty testifying to the Applicant's Serious Commitment to his/her Studies, Good Conduct and Other Achievements Including Active Participation in Extra & Co-Curricular Activities and Community Services; Weighted 20% of Total.
- Short 'Personal Statement' Essay, Not Exceeding One Type written Page, to allow the Applicant to Emphasize Any Particular/Outstanding Aspect of His/Her Application; Weighted 5% of Total.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: Apply for the 18th CYCLE ALF SCHOLARSHIP

- 25 Meritorious Students Will Be Selected by ALF Committees at different levels to be Recipients of the Aklilu Lemma Merit Scholarship Awards for the 2014/2015 Academic Year.
- Successful Applicants Will Be Awarded a Certificate of Merit, a Monthly Stipend of Eth. Birr 300.00 during the 2014/2015 Academic Year, and some Other Educational Support.
- As Always, ALF strives to ensure Reasonable Participation of Deserving Female Students in 2014/15.
- The Scholarship Award is Tenable for One Year and is Renewable until Graduation, provided the Awardee Maintains the CGPA Required for Renewal to be specified by committees at the time of selection.
- For any additional Information, Potential Applicants can Contact their Undergraduate Associate Deans, who are designated by the AAU & ALF governing body to serve as ALF representatives.
- NB. ALF provides scholarships exclusively for students who are not recipients of scholarships/grants.

II. APPLICANTS FOR RENEWAL OF ALF SCHOLARSHIP

ALF Scholarship Recipients of 2013/2014 Who are not Graduating at the end of the Academic Year and Who Wish to Continue with their Scholarships for 2014/2015 are **Required** to **Submit** the following before <u>01 of August/2014</u>: (i) Written Report about Benefits obtained During 2013/2014; (ii) A Formal Written Request Applying for Scholarship Renewal for the year 2014/2015; (iii) An Up-to-date Confidential Recommendation Letter from the Department/Faculty on the Special ALF Recommendation Letter Form provided; and (iv) a Copy of their Final Grade Reports of 2013/2014 Or an Up-to-date Transcript.

NOTE: Both NEW & RENEWAL Applications Will Be Received From 01 June to 31 July/2014. Please Pick Up (i) the Application Form and (ii) the ALF Recommendation Letter Form from Your College Or from the Central ALF Office, Located in the College of Natural Sciences; Freshman/Marshal Building (Room 106) and Submit complete Application up to 31 July '2014: No Application will be Accepted after this date! Incomplete Applications will Not be Considered.

Please Submit Complete Application in Person to the ALF Office Before the Deadline (31 July/2014), and Submit Your Transcript or Final Grade Report of Semester II (2013/14) to the ALF Office as soon as it is available.
