QZA-0483 ETH-16/0028 – BEYOND ACCESS: IMPROVING QUALITY OF EARLY YEARS READING INSTRUCTIONS IN ETHIOPIA AND SOUTH SUDAN

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THIS AGREEMENT (the Agreement) is entered into between the NORWEGIAN AGENCY FOR DEVELOPMENT COOPERATION (Norad) and ADDIS ABABA UNIVERSITY (AAU) (the Grant Recipient) (jointly referred to as the Parties).

WHEREAS the goal of the NORHED Programme is sustainable economic, social and environmental development in low and middle income countries (LMIC), and its purpose is to strengthen capacity in higher education institutions in LMIC to contribute to a) a more and better qualified workforce, b) increased knowledge, c) evidence-based policy and decision-making and d) enhanced gender equality;

WHEREAS Norad has provided financial support to QZA-0483 ETH-16/0028 – BEYOND ACCESS: Improving Quality of Early Years Reading Instructions in Ethiopia and South Sudan through agreement(s) dated 05th December 2016.

WHEREAS AAU in connection with the call for applications to the NORHED Programme in 2016, together with Bahir Dar University (BDU), University of Juba (UoJ) and Oslo and Akershus University College of Applied Sciences (HiOA) (the Partner Institutions), in the revised application with results framework, implementation plan and budget, dated 22nd November 2016, requested support to the project BEYOND ACCESS: Improving Quality of Early Years Reading Instructions in Ethiopia and South Sudan (the Project); and

WHEREAS Norad has decided to comply with the request for support under the NORHED Programme;

NOW THEREFORE the Parties have agreed as follows:

1 SCOPE AND OBJECTIVES

- 1.1 This Agreement, including all annexes, set forth the terms and procedures for Norad's financial support to the project titled: QZA-0483 ETH-16/0028 BEYOND ACCESS: Improving Quality of Early Years Reading Instructions in Ethiopia and South Sudan (the Project). The Project is further described in the revised application titled "BEYOND ACCESS: Improving Quality of Early Years Reading Instructions in Ethiopia and South Sudan", dated 24th November 2016 (the Application) and the estimated costs of the Project are indicated in the budget attached as Annex A.
